ED'S COMMENT

As September and Autumn 2021 arrives, countries across the world continue to manage the coronavirus pandemic. Different parts of the world have all coped as best they can, but the impact of this dreadful virus is still here for all to see. There is no doubt the UK is in a better place now than many others, having double vaccinated over 60% of the adult population, meaning some restrictions left can be eased. Covid-19 is possibly here to stay, infecting people who have even been vaccinated, but the jab is helping to minimise the effects and significantly cut down the numbers of those having the illness so severely they have to go to hospital or, even worse, do not survive.

We are learning to live with the virus, get on with our lives and work out what the 'new normal' looks like. Two things are for sure. Firstly, we have the flu jab to look forward to! Just when we thought we had got over our Covid jab our Health Centre will be contacting us for our flu jab very soon. Especially as flu almost disappeared last year being one of the success stories of the lockdowns, masks and isolation! The government is preparing to deliver the flu programme alongside any booster programme for COVID-19 vaccines as part of autumn and winter planning, which centres around protecting as many lives as possible. This signals what the future looks like with a Covid booster and flu jab in the autumn. During the 2021 to 2022 season, which starts this September, the flu jab will be available to:

- all children aged 2 and 3 on 31 August 2021
- children in primary school and all children in school years 7 to 11 in secondary school
- those aged 6 months to under 50 years in clinical risk groups
- pregnant women
- those aged 50 years and over
- unpaid carers
- close contacts of immunocompromised individuals
- frontline health and adult social care staff

Secondly, a much happier and far more exciting prospect, designed to boost our mental health and well being... *BNatural* is back! Bildeston's famous music festival kicks off proper at midday on 4th September on the main stage in Market Square. There is nothing that serves to demonstrate and underline everyone's determination to get back to some kind of normality more than the return of BNatural. If the weather can play its part and the sun shines down on us, we can meet up with friends and family as we have done for the past 10 years and enjoy an amazing mix of live music... yes, real live music... a wonderful variety of food and drink and enjoy a weekend of being entertained. Not just that but mingle with villagers, guests and those who want to join us in such a special event. Here's hoping it's as great as ever. Meanwhile, well done and huge thanks to the BNatural committee and army of volunteers who make it happen.

Sunflower Planting


Robin class enjoying planting their sunflowers in the front garden!



DISCOVER SOMETHING UNIQUE



Recipe of the Month Herbed Burgers

with thanks to Alison

Ingredients

THESE CAN BE TURKEY, PORK, CHICKEN OR VEGGIE ALTERNATIVE MINCE

makes 8 medium burgers

500g Mince of choice

1 red onion, coarsely grated

1 small courgette, coarsely grated

1 red pepper, deseeded and diced

2-3 tbsp finely chopped mixed herbs,

[eg. parsley,oregano and thyme or coriander]

1 tsp finely grated lemon zest

Freshly ground black pepper to taste

1tbsp sunflower oil for brushing



Method

- 1. Place all ingredients. Except the sunflower oil, in a large bowl and mix together. Using hands, shape mixture into 8 round flat burgers, each about 1.5cm thick. Place burgers on a plate and cover with cling film and chill for 30 mins
- 2.Preheat the grill to high or light the BBQ about 30-45 minutes before cooking to heat coals., gas BBQ about 10 mins before.
- 3.Lightly brush the burgers all over with the sunflower oil. Place on rack and grill for 15-20 mins until they are thoroughly cooked, turning once or twice. Grill about 8cm from heat source.
- 4. Serve the burgers in rolls or burger buns and secure them with cocktail sticks. This is particularly useful if loaded with a lot of salad!

BILDESTON PARISH COUNCIL VACANCY

The Parish Council is made up of nine elected or co-opted members who volunteer their time for the good of the community without receiving payment for their services. Their diverse backgrounds, skills and experience are a great asset to the parish.

The role of the Parish Council is to represent the interests of the whole community, engaging with local residents, discovering the needs of different groups in the community, such as the young and elderly, and lobbying on behalf of Bildeston. The Parish Council is the tier of local government that is closest to local people. Babergh District Council and Suffolk County Council form the other two tiers of local government that cover Bildeston. Details of their respective roles and responsibilities can be found in the Council services section of the website www.bildeston.org.uk Parish Councillors are subject to re-election every four years unless there are the same number (or less) of Councillors to vacancies in which case those nominees will be co-opted on to the Council. All Members of the Parish Council are required to comply with a Code of Conduct in the performance of their duties. I've heard that Universal Credit is going to be cut from September. I struggle to get by as it is and I'm really worried that if I lose £20 a week, I'll get into serious debt. I'm already behind on some of my bills. What can I do to avoid things getting worse?

You're not alone in this - there is support available.

Firstly, depending on your situation, you might be able to ask to have your Universal Credit paid differently - these are called 'alternative payment arrangements'. This might be an option if you're in debt or rent arrears, among other reasons. To apply for an alternative payment arrangement, call the Universal Credit helpline on: 0800 328 5644

If you're behind on some of your bills, the first step is to make a list of how much you owe and add up how much you need to pay each month.

You now need to prioritise your debts. We have <u>advice on our website</u> to help you do this. Some bills can cause you more problems than others if you don't pay them. Rent or mortgage arrears, energy bills and council tax are your priority debts as there can be serious consequences if you don't pay them.

Be sure to get in touch with the organisations you owe money to. Not everyone feels confident to do this, but they might be able to help by letting you pay smaller amounts or taking a break from payments. Many organisations have put in place protections for people who've struggled to pay their bills during the pandemic.

The government-backed <u>Breathing Space</u> scheme could also give you extra time. If you're eligible, you could get 60 days where your creditors can't contact you, take action to make you pay, or add interest and charges to your debt. You'll need to get advice from a debt adviser first - they'll check all your debts to see if they're covered by the scheme.

Finally, it's always a good idea to have a budget - take a look at the <u>budgeting tool</u> on our website <u>www.citizensadvice.org.uk</u> and make sure you're getting all the income you're entitled to.


