ED'S COMMENT

We live through history each and every day of our lives, every day something of note will be looked back at, studied and researched at some point in the future. However, some things happen that tower above the everyday as very special, possibly unique. Queen Elizabeth II Platinum Jubilee celebration is in that category. It is very doubtful that another monarch of any country, least of all ours, will ever reign for such a length of time again. And it has happened in our lifetime, we are part of, and witnessing, history in the making. That, in itself, makes this event very exciting.

Queen Elizabeth was just 27 years old when her father, King George VI, died. She was on an official tour of Africa in Kenya, flew out a princess and returned a Queen. For most of the population Elizabeth has been the only monarch they have ever known. Queen Elizabeth II has been our Head of State and a stable, secure example of duty and service for seventy years. For that reason alone it is hugely appropriate that we celebrate her longevity and achievements.

A special extended bank holiday weekend this month is the opportunity for communities throughout the United Kingdom to come together to celebrate this historic milestone. Thursday 2nd June is the Queen's Birthday Parade (Trooping the Colour) with over 1,400 soldiers, 200 horses and 400 musicians in the traditional Parade to mark The Queen's official birthday. From Buckingham Palace, the Parade will move down The Mall to Horse Guard's Parade, joined by Members of the Royal Family on horseback and in carriages. The Parade will close with the traditional RAF fly-past, watched by The Queen and certain members of the Royal Family from the Palace balcony. On Friday there is a service of Thanksgiving at St. Paul's Cathedral. On Saturday is the Platinum Party at the Palace. The BBC are broadcasting a special live concert from Buckingham Palace that will bring together some of the world's biggest entertainment stars to celebrate significant moments from The Queen's seventy years reign. Sunday has the Big Jubilee lunch and Platinum Pageant.

Meanwhile, in Bildeston, thanks to Chris Clarke and the planning group of village residents, Bildeston is having its own amazing programme of celebrations linked to the Platinum Jubilee. There are street parties from Friday, but the main event is on Sunday 5th June when we are all invited to the Sports Field for a village residents and their families' Platinum Jubilee celebration get together.

A wonderful carnival atmosphere awaits all Bildeston residents and their families with fun, food, games, and a whole host of activities to help us enjoy the moment with neighbours we know and neighbours we don't yet know, but will as a result of our get together as part of the Queen's Platinum Jubilee celebrations here in Bildeston. Huge thanks to all those who have been working behind the scenes, and on the day itself, to make it happen.







Recipe of the Month

Asparagus, Spínach and Smoky Papríka Butter Bean Salad with thanks to Alíson

Ingredients

200 g canned butter beans 2tsp olive oil

1tsp smoked paprika

1tsp chilli flakes

125g asparagus with woody part

of stems removed

1tsp sea salt

250g washed spinach leaves

1large roasted pepper finely sliced

120g crumbled feta

Dressing

1/2 juiced lemon

2tbsp olive oil

2 cloves crushed garlic

Seasoning

Method

- 1. Preheat oven to 200C / fan 180C gas mark 5
- 2. In a roasting pan, add the butter beans, rinsed and patted dry, the olive oil, the smoked paprika and the chilli flakes
- 3. Mix these together then push to one side of the tray and add to the empty side, the asparagus, then roll into the oily mixture.
- 4. Spread out the asparagus then sprinkle the beans and asparagus with the sea salt.
- 5. Place in the hot oven.
- 6. Roast for 12-15 minutes.
- 7. When cooked remove from tray and slice each asparagus spear into three pieces and leave to one side.
- 8. Make the dressing.
- 9. Add the spinach to the dressing, coating it all then add the asparagus pieces and gently turn.
- 10. Place these onto a presentation platter, scatter over the pepper slices, roasted beans and the crumbled feta and finish with a grind of black pepper

20mph scheme design

I have asked the engineer in charge of this project to proceed with the next stage. Below is the rough timetable that I was given at the start of this process.

- · 2 weeks to put a prelim design together
- 3 weeks for informal consultation Blue light services including the Police, Parish Council, SCC Councillors etc
- 3 weeks for compiling and instructing SCC Legal services and receiving the draft Legal



Orders & Notices

- 3 weeks formal advertising period same consultees for informal consultation plus the public
- 2 weeks to compile the TRO decision report
- Allow 2 week for the report to be considered by senior SCC Officers

Then once approved the works cost needs determining and a works pack produced

- · Allow 2 weeks for the detailed design to be costed by our commercial team
- Whilst that is being done compile a works pack (drawings, TM, CDM, schedules etc) Then once a works order has been received for the works and the money banked, task orders can be raised by our Operations Team and the work programmed.

Our Operations team have a 14 week window in which to implement the works. Normally works are implemented within 8 or so weeks.

Dropped kerb by former Post Office

I have asked Highways to proceed with this on the basis of 50:50 shared cost between the PC and my Local Highways Budget, and to time it with the 20mph road closure.

Newberry Farmhouse

I have asked for an update on where Highways are with consideration of bollard following our site meeting.

Pylons - now a North-South proposal as well

I have earlier reported that National Grid's project for a new pylon route from Bramford to Twinstead, was recently recommended with some conditions by Suffolk cabinet. Since then, a second line of pylons has been proposed going north-south through Suffolk, close to Hintlesham and East Bergholt. Our group has formally objected to this. We believe both lines could have been carried in an underwater cable to London.

Babergh Cabinet rejig

Following an internal row amongst the Conservative group at Babergh, the council leader and three others have quit the group to become "independent Conservatives", the cabinet has been reshuffled with Conservatives being removed and a Green councillor, Jane Gould will become portfolio holder for climate change. This is the first time the Greens have been allowed to form part of the cabinet at Babergh, despite them being the second largest party-political group.

PC agreed to publish in the Bugle and on the village noticeboard, the plans and maps for the 20mph scheme, once the schedule of works is to hand. Clerk to let the Chair of Governors of the Primary School know the progress. Clerk to contact SCC regarding display of plans.




