

May brings the coronation of His Majesty The King which will take place on Saturday 6 May 2023. The ceremony will see His Majesty King Charles III crowned alongside the Queen Consort, Camilla and to celebrate this historic event, there is a community get-together at the Sports Field in Consent Lane on Sunday 7th May. The last coronation of a king in this country took place in 1937, and this was the coronation of King George VI.

There is a photograph in the centre pages of this magazine (pages 26-27) that was kindly submitted by Pam Balls. It was taken in the yard of C K Squirrell & Sons at Church View Bildeston and shows one of their lorries decked out for the Coronation of George VI. Pam's father, Charles Squirrell, is in the light coloured suit in front of the cab and his nephew, Ben Garrod, is the boy in the cab.

The photographer who took this fabulous image was Percy William Finter (1882-1952). Percy ran a hairdressing and photography business in Bildeston and was also a sub postmaster and parish councillor. Apparently he was an accomplished musician and led a local dance band.

# VOLUNTEER WITH US IN OUR 40<sup>TH</sup> YEAR OF SUPPORTING FAMILIES IN SUFFOLK

Families Together Suffolk (formerly known as Home-Start Mid & West Suffolk) have been supporting families with children under the age of 11 in Suffolk for 40 years, by providing home visits and running family, perinatal and special educational needs groups. Families may need support due to situations as diverse as isolation, bereavement, multiple births, illness, disability, financial concerns, or because they are simply finding parenting a struggle. Our coordinators, group leaders and volunteers



provide invaluable practical and emotional support, and help build the familys' confidence and ability to cope. We just couldn't deliver these services without our amazing volunteers.

Our volunteers find their roles rewarding because as well as making a difference to families in their local community, they are meeting new people, building their own skills and confidence, and can participate in our ongoing programme of training such as first aid, perinatal mental health and our LENA speech and language programme. Volunteering also looks great on your C.V. if you are looking for paid work!

We run regular training courses for new volunteers as follows:

Home Visiting Volunteer (supporting a family in their own home) – this course runs for 6 weeks (excluding school holidays) from 10am to 2.30pm. The next course is due to start on 20<sup>th</sup> April and will take place in Eye, within easy reach of the A140.

**Family Group Volunteer** – this course runs several times a year via Zoom call. Safeguarding training will also be given.

We like to think that we have something for everyone who would like to use their skills to help others and to learn new skills too. The following roles are also available:

- Assisting in our charity shop in Eye, either customer facing or behind the scenes, or with the team in our eBay online selling hub in Stowmarket.
- Using your professional skills as a Trustee to help develop the organisation and ensure it is run to charity commission standards
- Run a Half Marathon for us! We are proud to be a charity partner for the Ipswich Half Marathon on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> September. If you would like to run, jog or walk to raise money for us, please contact us for more information. We also have vacancies for race marshalls on the day, so if you would like to be in the thick of the action, please let us know!







# **Coronation Chicken**

This is not the classic version but a very quick, very easy and tasty recipe for coronation chicken:

You will need about 500 g of shredded, cooked chicken, please don't cut it tidily with a knife, it tastes so much better when just shredded. Leftovers from your Sunday roast would work nicely, or you could just buy ready cooked or ready roasted chicken/chicken pieces, whatever you like.

For the coronation sauce you will need:

6 tbs Mayonnaise

2-3 tsp mild or medium curry powder

2 tbsp mango chutney

2 tbsp sultanas

Stir all the ingredients for the sauce together, add the shredded chicken and mix well. Check for seasoning.

To finish, sprinkle toasted flaked almonds and fresh coriander leaves over and a light squeeze of fresh lime (or serve with lime wedges on the side and **let people do their own squeezing)**.

For a quick canapé, serve the coronation chicken on a crispy little gem leave (the gluten free version) or on thinly cut, warm (and buttered) baguette slices.


