



BILDESTON BELL RINGERS



Recipe of the Month

German apple cake

The day before, mix and quickly kneed together:

195g margarine
100g sugar
300g plain flour
2 level tsp baking powder
Form into a ball, flatten, cling & chill over night.

Peel, core & dice

1 kg of apples, preferably something a bit tart.

Cook the apples in a pan - with a splash of lemon juice - until soften a little bit.

Roll out 2/3 of the dough, keep the remaining 1/3 chilled, lay into a round and lined springform. don't worry if it brakes, just patch it up. press it up the sides a bit too, prick with a fork all over and bake at 180 for approx. 10 minutes until golden.

Put the apples on top, roll out the remaining dough and cover the apples up completely.... again, don't worry if it breaks, patch it up, you are not after a smooth look anyway.

Bake for 35 minutes or so until golden in colour.
Once cooled, pour icing all over to cover the top completely: Add icing sugar to your food processor, start the engine and slowly add fresh lemon juice until you have a really thick icing that will only just pour. Let the icing set whilst the cake is still in the tin.

Would you like to try a slice before you bake? This cake will be served at the upcoming music festival (in the BNatural Tea Garden).

CARING FOR YOUR DOG DURING WARM WEATHER

Dogs lose heat through panting, can only sweat through their paws, and are at high risk of getting heatstroke. Follow our top tips to keep your dog cool in the heat.



WALKIES

- Head out in the early morning or late evening when it's cooler.
- Don't run or cycle with your dog when it's hot.
- Avoid pavements. If the ground is too hot to touch with your hand for a few seconds, it's too hot for paws!

KEEPING COOL

- Prevent sunburn by using pet-safe sunscreen on ear tips and nose.
- Brush your dog regularly to keep their coat thin and free from matts or knots.
- Use frozen toys, paddling pools or water sprinklers to entertain and cool your dog down.

REMEMBER:

Dogs can die in hot environments. See: rspca.org.uk/dogsinhotcars

Never leave pets in vehicles, caravans, conservatories or outbuildings in warm weather.

HEATSTROKE CAN KILL.

Know the signs of heatstroke and contact a vet immediately if you spot them: heavy panting, excessive drooling, lethargy, drowsiness, uncoordinated movements, a state of collapse and vomiting.

'Let Justice and Peace Flow'

We have now come to the end of school holidays and the beginning of the new school term. The harvest has been all gathered in and with any luck, we will still have many sunny and warm days, throughout this month to enjoy.

In the churches calendar we begin a season of creation, called 'Creationtide', starting from the 1st September until the 4th October. A time for the church to dedicated to God as Creator and Sustainer of life. We hold special services throughout this time, giving thanks for the world in which we live and to renew our commitment to caring for our planet.
